Application process	The application form can be found online <u>here</u> : The application must be sent to international.office@phtg.ch. You will need to attach the following documents and send them along with your application form: >An official transcript from their home university >Copy of your passport >Proof of health insurance valid in Switzerland (Overseas students are able to buy this insurance upon their arrival)
Visa information	Students from any of the EU/EFTA countries do not need a visa to study in Switzerland. However, you will need to apply for a resi- dence permit within 14 days of arrival. After your arrival you will go to the city council with the International Student Advisor to apply for an <u>L Permit</u> (max. one year stay in Switzerland). Students from other countries will receive a visa application infor- mation sheet, letter of invitation and checklist from PHTG's Interna- tional Student Advisor and are strongly recommended to start their visa application process as soon as they receive these documents.
Health insurance	Health insurance is compulsory for students staying in Switzerland longer than three months. Check before your exchange semester if your current health insurance is valid in Switzerland and what it covers (e.g. European Health Insurance Card). If not, please con- tact the International Student Advisor.

Grading System

All academic attainments are graded in accordance with the European Credit Transfer System ECTS. One credit is equivalent to 25-30 hours' work (student workload) and the ECTS grading scale A - F is used.

Grants

PHTG gives grants to incoming Erasmus students and staff within the SEMP Programme provided that there is enough funding available (limited for staff exchange). After arrival, incoming students receive a grant of CHF 1900 or CHF 2200 per semester, depending on the country of the home institution.
